## DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO OUR MAIN OFFICE IN BUENA VISTA

12847 U.S. Hwy 24 & 285, Buena Vista, CO 81211

### FROM BRECKENRIDGE { 1 hour }

Take Hwy 9 South 30 min. to Fairplay. At the traffic light turn right onto Hwy 285 South. Drive another 30 min. to the next cluster of businesses called Johnson Village. We are the 3rd business on the right.

### FROM KEYSTONE { 1.5 hours }

Take Hwy 6 west to Dillon and get on I-70 west. Then follow directions "FROM LEADVILLE, COPPER MTN. & FRISCO" (see directly below).

### FROM LEADVILLE, COPPER MTN. & FRISCO { 45 min. to 1.5 hours }

Take I-70 to Hwy 91 South (Exit 195, Copper Mtn to Leadville). Hwy 91 South will turn into Hwy 24 East in Leadville. Continue on Hwy 24 East; go 2 miles past Buena Vista and turn left staying on Hwy 24 East. { NOTE: YOU WILL HAVE TO TURN LEFT TO STAY ON HWY 24 EAST } After you turn, we are the 5th building on the left.

### FROM DENVER { 2 hours }

Take I-70 to C-470 East (Exit 260, Colorado Springs). Take Hwy 285 South to Johnson Village. We are the 3rd business on the right.

### FROM COLORADO SPRINGS { 1.75 hours }

Take Hwy 24 West to Johnson Village. We are the 3rd business on the right.

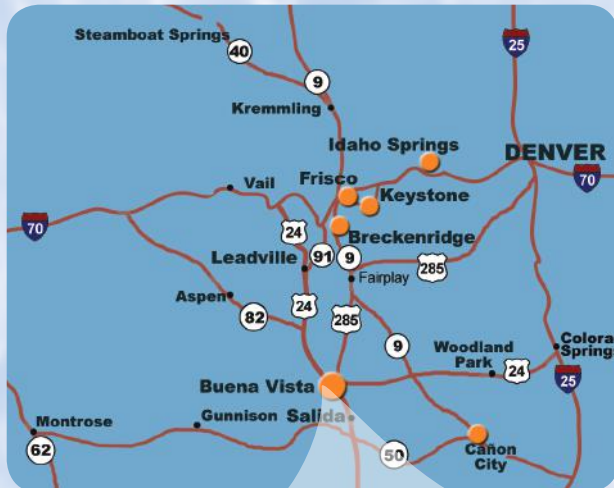

## RESERVATIONS

- Advanced reservations are highly recommended
- A 50% deposit is required at the time of booking. The remaining balance is due no later than 7 days prior to the trip date.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

## WHAT TO BRING:

- Comfortable clothing that will keep you warm when wet. Choose materials like neoprene, polypropylene, polyester or nylon.
- Shoes with a good sole that can get wet but stay on your feet. Sandals with a heel strap are acceptable.
- Sun protection - sunscreen, sunglasses, hats, lip balm and drinking water (all available in our outfitter store).
- Cameras should be waterproof (disposable cameras available in our outfitter store).
- Guide gratuities are greatly appreciated.

## WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Avoid wearing cotton, as it makes you colder when wet.
- Do not wear Flip Flops or Crocs.
- Anything valuable that you do not want to risk losing.

## WHAT IS PROVIDED:

- Helmets and Type V Coast Guard Approved PFD's (Personal Flotation Devices or "life jackets").
- Sanitized wetsuits, splash jackets, neoprene shoes and dry bags for a small rental fee.
- All necessary equipment for your adventure.
